



2016 Summit County Rocky Mountain Nordic Junior National Qualifier

Summit Nordic Ski Club in partnership with sponsors, Breckenridge Grand Vacations and BGV Gives, Pinnacle Mountain Homes and VisitBreck, is hosting a Junior National qualifier race weekend at Gold Run Nordic in Breckenridge on December 17-18, 2016. We expect over 300 athletes from clubs and colleges across Colorado to convene in Summit County for this year's first of four qualifying race weekends. Athletes aged seven through college-age will compete over two days in both Classic and Skate disciplines.



Saturday's race will be an individual start skate race ranging from 1K – 10K depending on age. Sunday's race will be a mass start classic race ranging from 1K-10K. Both races will give athletes qualifying points toward this year's Junior National Championship held in Lake Placid, New York in March 2017. The race weekend will also be a regional qualifier for the USCSA college circuit, which includes Western State, University of Wyoming, and Grand Mesa.

This is the first Nordic race weekend held at Gold Run Nordic in a number of years and we are excited to give local athletes a chance to compete on their home course with their community's support.
